Back-to-School Organisation

As a large number of families is expected, we kindly ask everyone to show their usual courtesy and cooperation to help ensure smooth traffic flow and parking.

What your child should bring

Primary School - Whenever possible, families are invited to bring **all of their child's school supplies** to the classroom on the first day, where they will be stored.

Secondary School (Collège) - Students do **not** need to bring textbooks or school supplies on this day, **except** for:

- Pencil case
- Student diary/planner
- Rough notebook



Student Drop-Off Procedures on the First Day

NEW

Nursery School

Families with children in Nursery are requested to park in the **new Nursery car park** (see map on page 4) and enter through the **Nursery entrance**.

Families accompanying children in both Nursery and Primary and/or Secondary School may then use the **internal gate** to access the Primary/Secondary area (see map on page 4).

Primary & Secondary School

All parents are invited to park in the **new parent car park** and enter through the **new Primary/Secondary entrance** (see map).

- Parents of Primary pupils may accompany their child to the classroom.
- Secondary School students will enter the school independently.

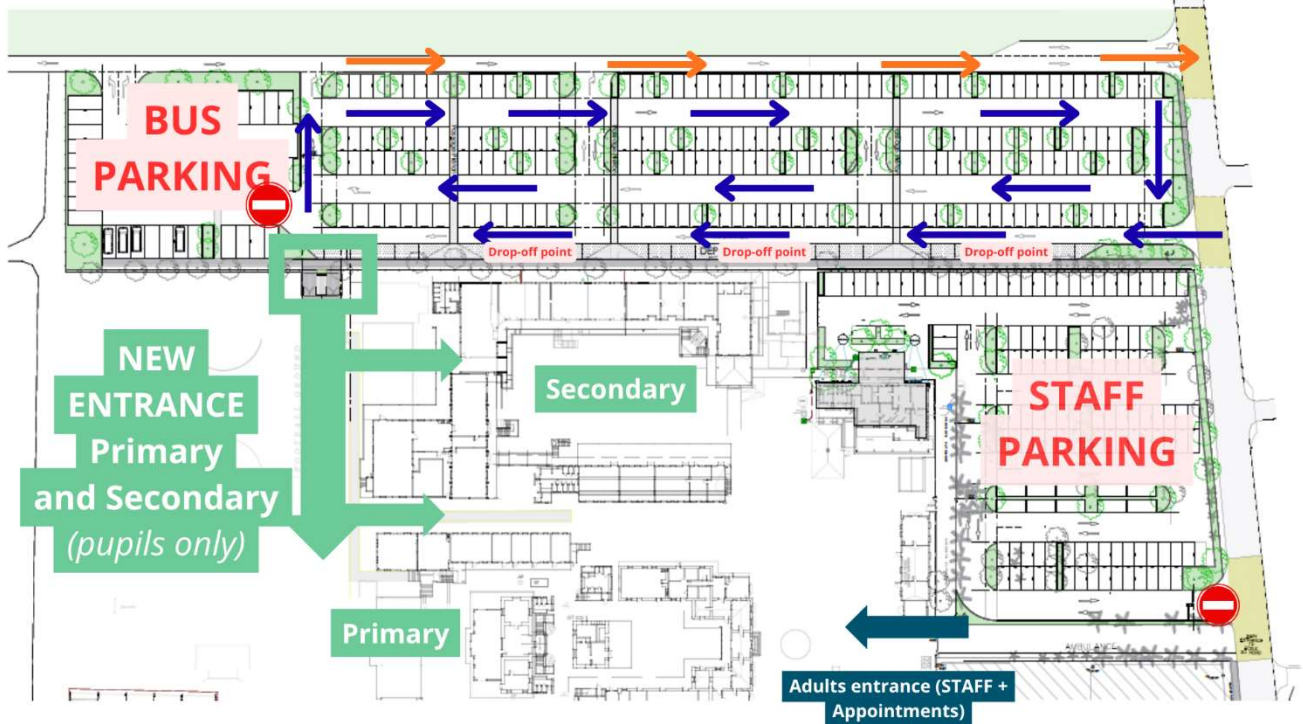
Student Pick-Up Procedures on the First Day

NEW – Primary & Secondary

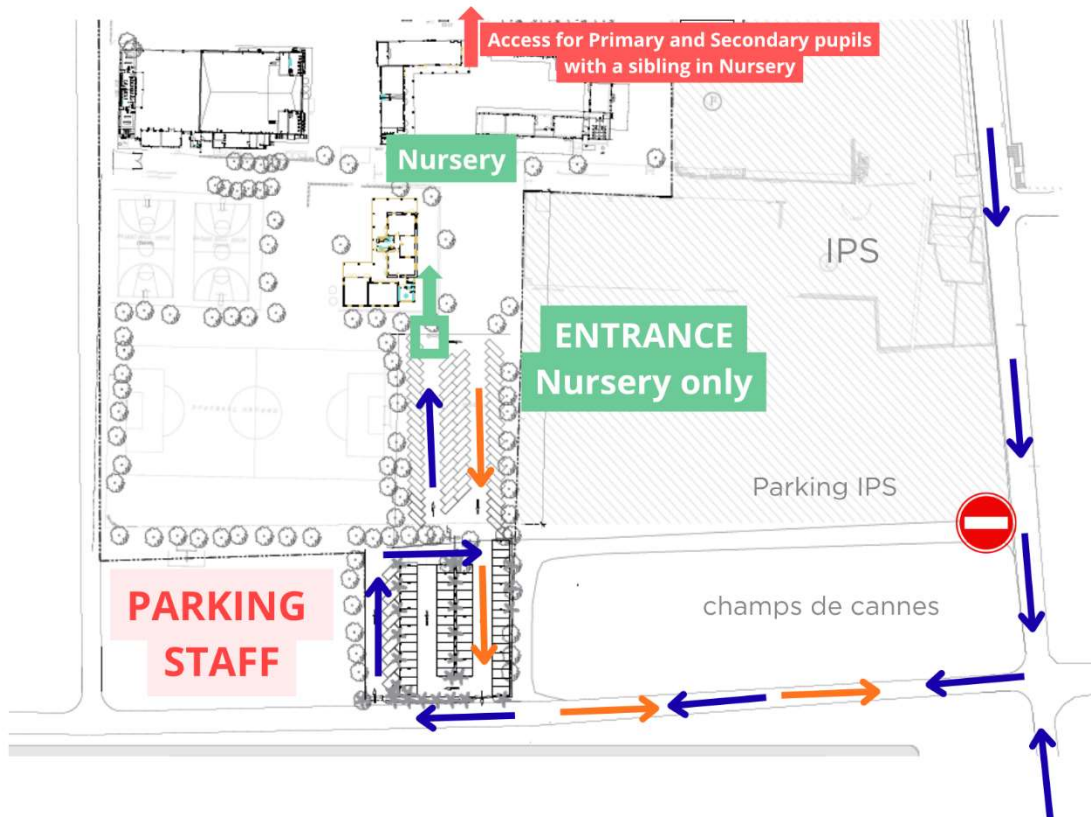
As an exceptional arrangement for the first day only, Primary and Secondary School students may be collected **inside the school grounds**, on the **main field**, via the **new Primary/Secondary entrance** (see map on page 4).

To facilitate organisation, families are kindly requested to wait beside the sign indicating their child's year group. Teachers will escort the students to the main field for dismissal.

Monday, 31 August 2026 (Regular timetable and school transport service)

Nursery (PS, MS, GS) - First day of school for all Nursery pupils - 7:45 a.m. – 11:45 a.m.

- **8:15 a.m.** – Information meeting in the gymnasium and school transport information stands.

Primary (CP to CM2) - 7:45 a.m. – 2:20 p.m. - Full school day.

Secondary School (Years 6 to 9 / 6e to 3e) - Regular timetable according to each student's class schedule (morning and afternoon classes).

Security

- All visitors and parents must report to Reception, and are required to sign the visitor register and wear a visitor badge.
- **Primary & Secondary School** - No visitor access to the school campus will be permitted through the new Primary/Secondary entrance. All visitors must enter via Reception.
- **Nursery School** - Outside the designated drop-off and pick-up times, access through the Nursery gate will not be permitted.



School Hours – 2026–2027

From **7:00 a.m.**, students may be dropped off and will be supervised at the school gates.

Nursery pupils arriving by school bus will be escorted from the bus to the Nursery entrance by the bus drivers and welcomed by the Nursery teaching assistants.

Waiting in the car parks is not permitted.

Online Registration via Eduka

Families wishing their child to receive school meals from the **first week of school** must register online through **Eduka** between **21 and 26 August 2026**. Registration procedures will be sent by email and published on the school's website. We encourage families to complete their registration during this period to ensure the smooth organisation of the catering service.
